

that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope. And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

Unison: Almighty Father, forgive us for fearing death and giving it more power over our lives than it deserves. We know that You have defeated it and drained it of power through Your resurrection. Help us to live in the hope of eternal life and put aside our fear of death. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

ASSURANCE OF PARDON (Romans 5:6-11)

Leader: You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous person, though for a good person someone might possibly dare to die. But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Since we have now been justified by His blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through Him! For if, while we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to Him through the death of His Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through His life! Not only is this so, but we also boast in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation.

Sisters and brothers in Christ, believe the good news: through faith in Christ we are forgiven.
