CALL TO CONFESSION: (II Peter 2:4-10a)

Leader: For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but sent them to hell, putting them in chains of darkness to be held for judgment; if He did not spare the ancient world when He brought the flood on its ungodly people, but protected Noah, a preacher of righteousness, and seven others; if He condemned the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah by burning them to ashes, and made them an example of what is going to happen to the ungodly; and if He rescued Lot, a righteous man, who was distressed by the depraved conduct of the lawless (for that righteous man, living among them day after day, was tormented in his righteous soul by the lawless deeds he saw and heard)— if this is so, then the Lord knows how

to rescue the godly from trials and to hold the unrighteous for punishment on the day of judgment. This is especially true of those who follow the corrupt desire of the flesh and despise authority.

Let us repent of our ungodly behavior and seek God's forgiveness through the confession of our sin. Please join me in silent prayer.

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

Unison: Gracious God, forgive us for being intolerant of the weaknesses of others. We are easily angered and frustrated by others but tolerant of our own failings. Help us to bear with each other as we journey toward Holiness together. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

ASSURANCE OF PARDON: (2 Peter 3:10-15)

Leader: But the day of the Lord will come like a thief. The heavens will disappear with a roar; the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything done in it will be laid bare. Since everything will be destroyed in this way, what kind of people ought you to be? You ought to live holy and godly lives as you look forward to the day of God and speed its coming. That day will bring about the destruction of the heavens by fire, and the elements will melt in the heat. So then, dear friends, since you are looking forward to this, make every effort to be found spotless, blameless and at peace with Him. Bear in mind that our Lord's patience means salvation!
